
Exterior Hole Solutions



Having a little hole in the wall as a mouse house is cute in cartoons, but awful in real life! We had a mouse problem in our house and the exterminator found this tricky little hole in our siding where he suspected mice were entering our home. We grabbed DAP Mouse Shield, DAP Platinum Patch, a piece of repair screen and a scraper to fix the problem.

INSTRUCTIONS

First we filled the hole with DAP Mouse Shield. This product is for indoor use only, but since we are covering it up with waterproof Platinum Patch, it should work like a charm! First we filled the hole and allowed time for it to expand and dry. (If there is excess Mouse Shield foam sticking out of the hole from the expansion, just use a utility knife to cut it flush with the wall.) Next, we stuck our screen repair over the hole to give the Platinum Patch a surface to cover. We applied Platinum Patch with a scraper and allowed to dry. Once dry, we sanded it down so it was relatively smooth and then painted over it!
